What is a Pilgrimage?

A Pilgrimage is a **sacred** journey undertaken for a **spiritual** purpose.

A **Pilgrim** is a person who goes on a Pilgrimage.

Why do you think people go for pilgrimage?








The most famous Hindu pilgrimage is the Kumbh Mela which takes place at the River Ganges in India. In Judaism, the key focus for pilgrimage is **Jerusalem**, the site of the ancient temple destroyed by Romans in 70CE of which the **Western Wall** remains.

Pilgrimage in Islam

- In Islam, the pilgrimage is known as Hajj.
- * Hajj is one of the **5 pillars of Islam**.
- Muslims are required to go for Hajj to Makkah (Mecca), a holy city in Saudi Arabia, at least once in their life:
 - \checkmark if they are fit;
 - \checkmark can afford it; and
 - \checkmark it is safe to do so.

The Holy City of Makkah (Mecca)

Muslims face the Holy Ka'aba in Makkah when they pray

Makkah is the birthplace of the founder of Islam, the **Holy Prophet Muhammad** (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him).

The Holy Ka'aba stands in the middle of a large courtyard of Masjid al Haram, or 'The Sacred Mosque', in Makkah.





How is Hajj performed?



- The Hajj lasts for 12-13 days with 11 different steps during which Pilgrims travel across different parts of Makkah.
- Men wear two white seamless sheets. Women wear traditional clothing and cover their head but not their face.
- Although not part of the prescribed Pilgrimage, many Pilgrims carry on to the city of Medinah in Saudi Arabia and visit 'Al Masjid an Nabawi' known as the Prophet's Mosque.



Eid ul Adha



Hajj reminds Muslims about the story of **Prophet Abraham** (peace be upon him) and teaches them about sacrifice.


What is sacrifice?
