Who is the Holy Prophet of Islam?

- The Holy Prophet of Islam is Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him).
- The Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) was born in 570 AD in Makkah (also spelt as Mecca) in Saudi Arabia.
- The Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) is the founder of

Islam.

The Early Years

- The Holy Prophet's (peace and blessings of Allah be upon) father's name was Abdullah and his mother's name was Aminah.
- The Holy Prophet's (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) father passed away before his birth and his mother died when he was just 6 years old.
- He was left in the care of his grandfather, Abdul Muttalib following whose death, he was looked after by his uncle, Abu Talib.
- Despite these hardships, The Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) grew up to be an honest, truthful and intelligent person.
- He led a pious and simple life and was wellknown for his willingness to help others.

The conduct of the Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) earned him the titles of As-Siddique (meaning the most truthful) and Al-Amin (meaning the most trustworthy).

Pre-Islam Makkah (Mecca)



Despite the corrupt society around him, the childhood and youth of the Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) remained pure and clean. Allah safeguarded him against every form of evil.

Revelation

- The Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) used to spend a lot of time in the remembrance of Allah. He would go and pray in a cave called Hira that lay a few miles from Makkah.
- One night during the month of Ramadan when he was forty years old, the Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) had a vision whilst praying in the cave of Hira. In this vision, the Angel Gabriel appeared and conveyed to him the first Quranic revelation from Allah.
- This marked the beginning of the mission of the Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) as a Prophet and Messenger of Allah.

Over the next 23 years the entire Holy Qur'an was revealed to the Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) and to this day its text remains completely unchanged.

The Mission of The Holy Prophet Muhammad

(peace and blessings of Allah be upon him)

- The Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) preached the unity of God. He said that to achieve peace, people must fulfil their obligations to both God and to mankind.
- His mission was to remove evil and injustice and to establish goodness and piety in the world.
- The Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) invited the whole world to Islam but also granted everyone the freedom to practice their own faith.



- His Life. The Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) passed away in 622 CE at the age of 63.
- His Legacy. He left behind a very pious and righteous community of believers who continued his mission to spread Islam to all parts of the World.
- His Mosque. Al Masjid an-Nabawi 'The Prophet's Mosque' is situated in the city of Medina. It is one of the largest Mosques in the World. The compound of Mosque also houses where the Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) is buried.
- Islam today. Today there are almost two billion Muslims worldwide and Islam is the second largest religion in the world.
