| <ul> <li>What is the Holy Qur'an and why is it important to Muslims?</li> <li>Go through the slides (<i>see Teachers' notes for support</i>).</li> <li>Stop after each slide giving the children an opportunity to Think, Pair, Share.</li> <li>Use the link in Slide 3 to watch a short video introducing the Holy Qur'an.</li> <li>Use the Audio Link in Slide 7 to listen to a recitation of the Holy Qur'an.</li> <li>Discuss any unfamiliar vocabulary and start a word wall for the unit.</li> <li>Use the link to an online class quiz to see how much children remember about the topic.</li> <li>Discuss any unfamiliar vocabulary and start a word wall for the unit.</li> </ul> |  | <ul> <li>Children should understand that the Holy<br/>Book for Muslims is the Holy Qur'an but that<br/>Muslims believe in and accept all the Holy<br/>Books sent to Prophets before the Holy<br/>Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of<br/>Allah be upon him) (<i>reference slide 6 of the</i><br/><i>presentation</i>). The Prophet of Islam is the<br/>Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and<br/>blessings of Allah be upon him) but Muslims<br/>believe in all the Prophets, including<br/>Prophet Jesus and Prophet Moses (peace be<br/>upon them both). These beliefs in all the<br/>Holy Books and all the Prophets are both<br/>'Articles of Faith' in Islam which children<br/>will learn about in KS2.</li> </ul> |  |  |
