<u>Teaching Input</u>		<u>Reinforcement Points</u>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> What do we know about Islam? Go through the slides introducing Islam (<i>see Teachers' notes for support</i>). Stop after each slide giving the children an opportunity to Think, Pair, Share. Watch the video about Hajj (<i>link in Slide 6</i>). Discuss any unfamiliar vocabulary and start a word wall for the unit. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Some children may not be aware about the conditions for performing Hajj and deem it compulsory in all circumstances. Children should understand that Muslims are required to go for Hajj once in their life if they are fit, can afford it and it is safe to do so.

<u>Practical Ideas</u>			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Show the children a special compass that points out the direction of Makkah. When is it used? Explain that Muslims always Pray facing towards the Holy Ka'aba in Makkah. List some items you would take on Hajj with you. Explain why you would need each of these items. Draw some pictures next to the items. 			
<u>Extension Task</u>			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Using the internet (Google Earth: https://www.google.co.uk/intl/en_uk/earth/) locate Saudi Arabia and try to find the different places Muslims visit as part of Hajj. 			
<u>Plenary</u>		<u>AfL Questions</u>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Using a story board, revise the steps of Hajj from the Information Sheet. What is it about Hajj that makes it so important to Muslims? 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do children know that Hajj is a pillar of Islam? Do children know what happens on Hajj (who/when/where/why)? Do children understand that the concept of pilgrimage is not exclusive to Islam but that it is also found in other religions?
