<u>Teaching Input</u>		<u>Reinforcement Points</u>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> What do we know about the Prophet Muhammad*? Why is the Holy Prophet Muhammad so important to Muslims? Go through the slides on The Life of the Holy Prophet Muhammad* (<i>see Teachers' notes for support</i>). Stop at appropriate intervals and give the children an opportunity to Think, Pair, Share. Discuss any unfamiliar vocabulary and start a word wall for the unit. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Some children may consider that Muslims only believe in one Prophet, The Holy Prophet Muhammad*. Muslims believe in all the Prophets of Allah (this is one of The Articles of Faith in Islam), including Prophet Jesus and Prophet Moses (peace be upon them both). They are all honoured as true Messengers of God.

<u>Activity 1</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Using the word bank, children to complete the sentences about the Holy Prophet Muhammad* and recall some of his noble characteristics. 	<u>Activity 2</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Using the word bank, children to complete the sentences about the Holy Prophet Muhammad* and recall some of his noble characteristics. 	<u>Activity 3</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Using the word bank, children to complete the sentences about the Holy Prophet Muhammad* and recall some of his sayings (hadith). 	
<u>Practical Ideas</u>			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Holy Qur'an, the Holy Book of Muslims, was revealed to the Holy Prophet Muhammad*. Show the children a copy of the Holy Quran. The first verse of the Holy Qur'an revealed to the Holy Prophet Muhammad* was from Chapter 96 (Sura Al-Alaq). Show the children Chapter 96. Children can listen to Chapter 96 being recited using the link given below. 			
<u>Extension Task</u>			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The video in the presentation explains the kind and forgiving nature of the Holy Prophet Muhammad*. Ask children to list/discuss with partner/share with the class examples of when they have shown kindness and forgiveness towards others. 			

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<u>Plenary</u>	<u>AfL Questions</u>
<p>Revise the Early years in the Life of the Holy Prophet Muhammad* and the condition of Makkah before Islam. How did Islam change Makkah and the world? (link this to the Mission of the Holy Prophet Muhammad*).</p> <p>Discuss some of the sayings of Holy Prophet Muhammad from the presentation and the message they convey. Invite children to share any sayings they have heard (eg from parents/teachers) or abide by in their life.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Who was the Holy Prophet Muhammad* and why is he so important to Muslims? • What is the name of the Holy Book of Muslims revealed to the Holy Prophet Muhammad*? • What was the Mission of the Holy Prophet Muhammad? • Who do you admire/aspire to be like/look up to for guidance/support and why?
